Subject: Some positives during 2nd Lockdown - Popup Coffee cart, Popup Shop, Home cooked Meals Takeaway, Playpark opening and a Crowdfund opportunity all on your doorstep.

Hi to you all,

I hope yourself and all of your residents are managing under this 2nd Lockdown, we currently find ourselves in.

I am emailing to give you an update on the current CCDT initiatives at this time.

Our original **Covid support Volunteers** are still active and doing regular shopping for just a handful of clients currently. These few people have not been to a shop because of age or illness.

Pop – up **Coffee Cart** @ The Pavilion on Havenstoke Park – CCDT have a Coffee Cart and are currently serving, locally roasted HOST Coffee, and other Hot drinks as a takeaway. This cart is managed almost entirely by our CCDT Barista Volunteers. The Cart is proving to be a popular place for everyone enjoying the park to stop , albeit briefly, and buy a Hot drink. It's also the opportunity to have a brief ,socially distanced , conversation and for those living alone this is very important currently. Opening from 9.30 till 2.30 each day.

We also have 'Refilled' from Drapers Yard set up a **pop –up shop** @ The Pavilion too. Giving locals the opportunity to buy some basics, without heading into town. Opening times as above.

And from today our **Sunday Lunch Chef Helen** has created some home cooked meals to take away from The Pavilion, all available between 9.30 and 2.30 each day. This week she has made Lasagne, Chicken & Chorizo Pie, Edamame & Lentil ragout. each are £5.50.

Kids Playpark – We have finally got an open Playpark on Graylingwell Park, after much hard work from all sides, this opened on Monday. This Park is the one North of the Graylingwell Chapel, the one on Havenstoke Park is still closed off.

And finally.....

CCDT are Crowdfunding for the Pavilion project on Havenstoke Park. We wondered if you could share this initiative with your contacts and colleagues. This is to fund some equipment and resources for the project which are outside of the 'capital build' element of the project. We are shortly turning the space into a space for mind and body wellness and a lovely café!
