The site is hand written and there are no links to other people's code libraries (for scripting or style sheets etc.)

All areas of the site are accessible to the general public. We have considered a members only area, but that would require password protection and administration for forgotten passwords etc. And anyway, we have no secrets!

The Webmaster welcomes input but retains editorial control in order to give the site a consistent look-and-feel.

Updates to the site are made as required, either by direction of the committee or on the webmaster's initiative.

Major changes and new functions are tested on multiple browsers (currently Chrome, Firefox, Edge and Safari) and on PC and mobile platforms.

All changes are recorded in a maintenance log.
